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MANAGEMENT EDUCATION COMMITTEE CANDIDATE SELECTION PROTOCOL

The LACMC Management Education Committee (Committee) is comprised of fifteen (15) members, including the Chair who is appointed by the LACMC Executive Committee Vice-President. The following protocol will be used for the application and screening of candidates to fill any vacancy on the Committee.

Candidates must:

1. Be a current dues-paying LACMC member.
2. Have attended at least two LACMC events (seminar and/or conference) during the past 12 month period.
3. Complete an "Application for Membership," including securing the endorsement of their County Department Executive (Department Head, Chief Deputy, or Administrative Deputy).
4. Submit a candidate statement: a paragraph describing their potential to contribute toward the professional development of the LACMC membership. (maximum 200 words)
5. Make an in-person presentation/interview to the Committee.
